1. Declaration of Conformity - RoHS

We hereby declare that our products are compliant to RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Union relating to the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic appliances.

2. Declaration of Conformity - REACH

In the sense of the Regulation for the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restrictions of Chemical (REACH) 1907/2006 of the European Parliament, Invacare is defined as a "Downstream User" for its manufactured products

Our products are non-chemical products that will not require registration under Article 7.1 of REACH. Furthermore, our products do not release hazardous substances if used as specified Consequently, we are not required to register chemical substances at the European Chemicals Agency (ECH{A) or to establish safety data sheets for our products.

Based on the actual information by our suppliers (regarding Article 33) we can confirm that all our products do not contain any of the substances specified in the so-called ECHA "candidate list" SVHC-Substances of Very High Concern (REACH Article 59) with a concentration of more than 0.1 % by weight.
